THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY MAYOR JEFF DAUGHERTY

COUNCIL MEMBERS PRESENT CLYDE HARPER, GINGER SIMS, AND BRYAN SUMMERVILLE.

COUNCIL MEMBERS ABSENT: RICK THELEN AND BOB TARDIFF

GINGER SIMS SAID THE INVOCATION AND MAYOR JEFF DAUGHERTY LED THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE.

A. **DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO CONTINUE OR EXTEND THE CITY OF LINDALE DECLARATION OF DISASTER DUE TO PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY.** MAYOR DAUGHERTY MADE A DECLARATION OF LOCAL DISASTER DUE TO PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY FOR THE CITY OF LINDALE. THE CITY WILL CLOSE AND LIMIT CITY ACTIVITIES OVER THE NEXT 30 DAYS UNTIL APRIL 16, 2020, AT WHICH TIME, THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL WILL RE-EVALUATE. CHIEF SOMES UPDATED COUNCIL ON LATEST REPORTS FROM CDC AND OTHER SURROUNDING CITIES HE IS GETTING DAILY BRIEFING. CAROLYN CALDWELL, CITY MANAGER, STATED THE CITY IS TAKING PREVENTIVE SAFETY AND CLEANING MEASURES IN ALL AREAS OF THE CITY. GINGER SIMS MADE A MOTION IN SUPPORT OF DECLARATION OF DISASTER DUE TO PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY. SECOND BY CLYDE HARPER. ALL VOTED IN FAVOR.

B. **DELIBERATION AND ACTION TO CLOSE ALL CITY FACILITIES CANCEL ALL EVENTS AT CITY FACILITIES AND TAKE ANY OTHER ACTION NEEDED TO PROTECT THE CITY AND ITS CITIZENS FROM THE THREAT OF THE CORONAVIRUS PANDEMIC.** BRYAN SUMMERVILLE MADE A MOTION TO CANCEL ALL EVENTS AT CITY FACILITIES AND TAKE OTHER ACTION AS NEEDED TO PROTECT THE CITY AND ITS CITIZENS FROM THREAT OF THE CORONAVIRUS PANDEMIC. SECOND BY GINGER SIMS. ALL VOTED IN FAVOR.
